## OUR TEACHERS

CHRIS HARFORD

Chris is Canberra Potters' Society's resident potter. He has been a potter for more than 25 years, 20 of them as a professional. Chris has taught for the Society since 1996.

JANE CRICK

Introducing others to exploration in the medium of clay is a source of constant pleasure to Jane. She has been a teacher for the Society since 1992.

GARRY PALECEK

A potter for more than 30 years, trading as Tallaganda Pottery on the main street of Braidwood from 1980 to 1998, Garry has taught adult and children's classes for the Society since 1999.

ALEX DE VOS

Alex's liking for fantasy creatures is reflected in the dragons and gargoyles that frequently form decorative or design elements of his work. Alex has been an active children's teacher for the Society since 1988.

CATHY FRANZI

Cathy has worked full-time with clay since 1997. Her own work focuses on thrown and altered functional ware. She has taught adult and children's classes for the Society since 1998.

MARYKE HENDERSON

Maryke has taught for many years in educational establishments, workshops and from her own studio when she lived in the New England region of NSW. She has been teaching for the Society since 2005.

### GENERAL COURSE DETAILS & CONDITIONS

**Handbuilding** incorporates the use of coiling, modelling and slab-building techniques to manipulate clay into more free-form pieces.

**Wheelwork** involves learning throwing and associated skills on the potters' wheel. As a beginner you will be taught how to centre clay and pull up a basic cylinder. This form is the stepping-stone to more complex shapes such as bowls, plates, etc.

**In all classes** you will learn to wax, decorate and glaze your pots and although the work is fired for you, a fundamental knowledge of the firing process will be gained.

**The adult course firing charge** is \$4.40/kg; this includes bisque (first firing), glaze firing and use of glazes. A range of **clays** is available priced from approx. \$13 per 10kg bag. Tools are also available for purchase. (CPS members receive discounts on firing and clay costs.)

Any classes missed may be made up at any time during the term at an equivalent class without notice, but missed classes **will not** be transferred to the next term.
